What is a Clicker?

Clickers, also sometimes referred to as Student Response Systems (SRS) or Personal Response Systems (PRS), are a technology that allows Emory faculty to gain immediate feedback from students during class. Polling students is especially useful in large classrooms where the traditional raising-of-hands is impractical. Electronic polling also allows all students to have an equal voice in classroom activities.

The system is comprised of a handheld transmitter (often called a "clicker"), and a single USB receiver connected by the instructor to a laptop or to a dedicated classroom computer. Instructors must first create polling questions using PowerPoint and the clicker system software. The response system may also be used to engage students with questions on digital content that lives outside of PowerPoint.

During class sessions, students respond to the questions using their handheld clickers. The results are automatically tabulated and displayed on the instructor's computer (and projection screen if desired). Many faculty have found clicker technology to be an enriching part of the classroom experience, adding to the level of engagement with the content and making large lectures more interesting for everyone.
