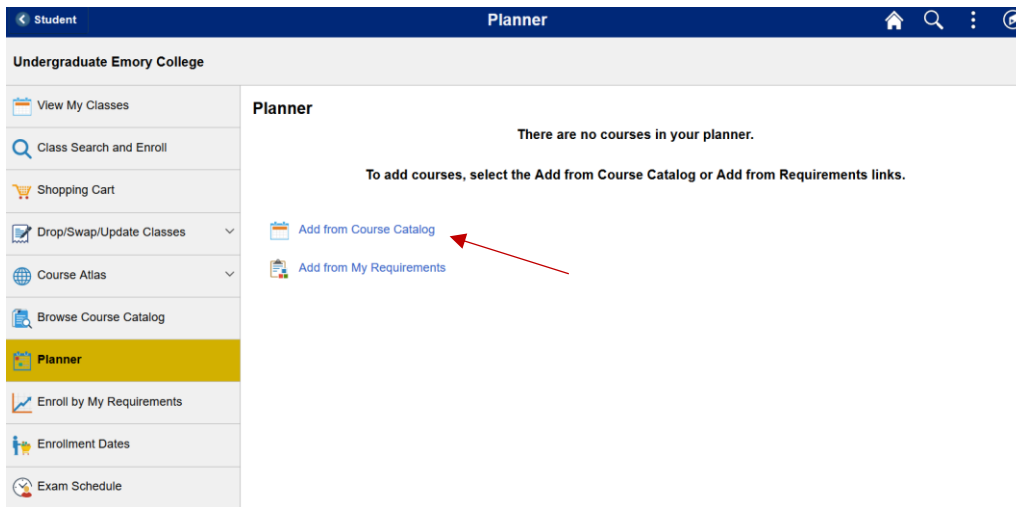


Select the “Course Planning and Enrollment” tile to *add courses to your planner from course catalog*.



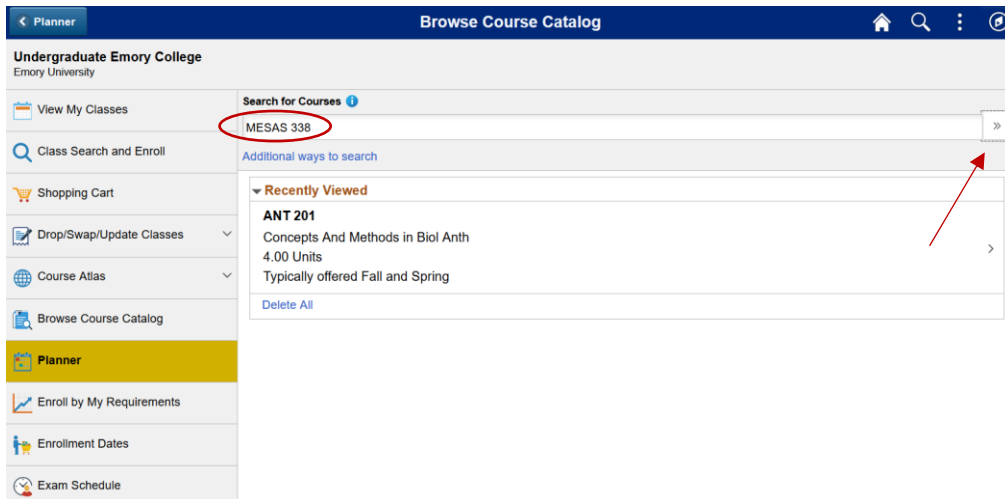
The planner process begins with the “Planner” option.

You can add courses to your planner from your academic requirements (*this option will only be available if your school has made your degree audit available online*).

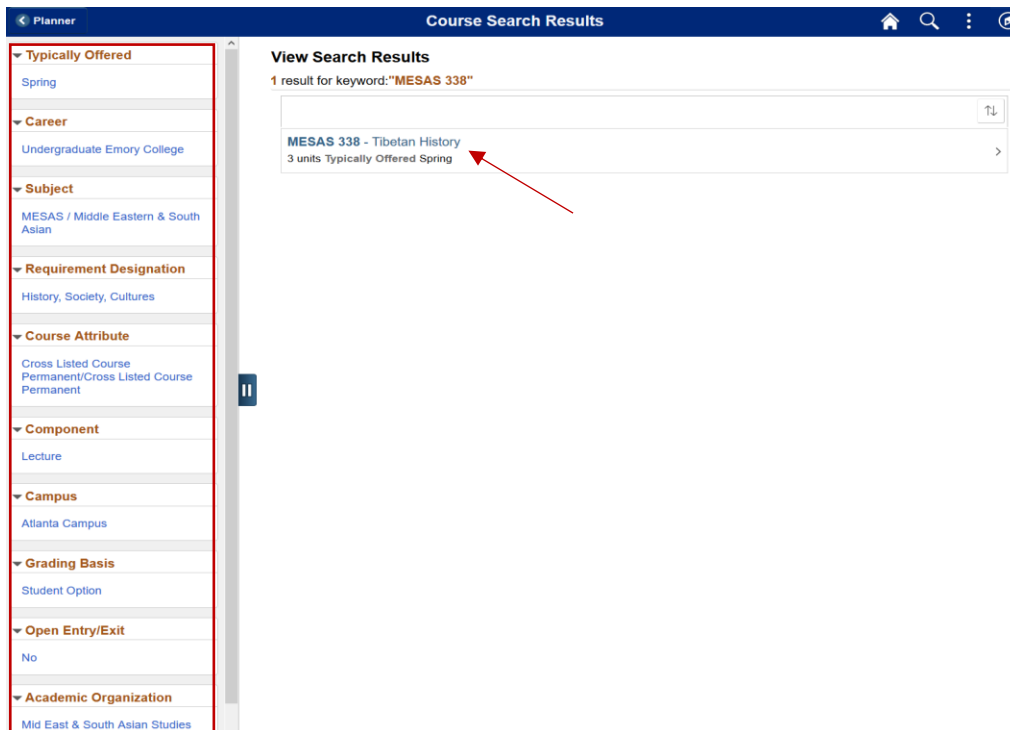
Click the “Add from Course Catalog” link.

Under the “Recently Viewed” section, you will see courses you have recently searched for and selected. This feature provides a convenient way to view and add to your planner a previously searched for course.




Search for class MESAS 338 returns results for the course with information about course units and typical term offerings.


