- GSA is installed and in production
  - Currently in use by

  - In testing with

- Making it available to campus users



### **Google Search Appliance**

- Advantages of the GSA
  - Can have control over results and presentation
  - Constant spidering
  - Can establish custom synonyms and weighting



### **Google Search Appliance**

- Getting Started Available Today!
  - Can use public catalog and template
  - Can request custom catalog
  - Can request admin account
    - Control over your template
    - Control over returns
  - Documentation / training session in May



### Web Analytics

- Replacing WebTrends for Web statistics
- Commodity stats processor will be AWStats
- Current status
  - Working out authentication details
  - Planning move to enterprise VM environment
  - Expect go-live in May



### Web Hosting Migration

- Migration going smoothly
  - 80% of sites migrated
  - Re-import of various sites due to extended/delayed testing periods
  - Home page migrated last week!!
- Next steps
  - Complete SiteMinder and secure.web migrations
  - Complete and test permission manager



### **Enterprise Content Management**

- Content management system implementation in support of Emory home page redesign
- Committee choose Hannon Hill Cascade Server
  - Java-based CMS
  - Entirely XML/XSLT-based
  - Scores high marks for support and flexibility



### **Enterprise Content Management**

- CMS implementation of home page, strategic plan, news sites will take place over summer
- CMS will be available for broad campus use in fall '08
- Primary method to use new templates designed by ECG
- UTS/HH will provide training sessions for content editors and admins
  - Spring, Summer, and Fall sessions
